But also needs specific considerations



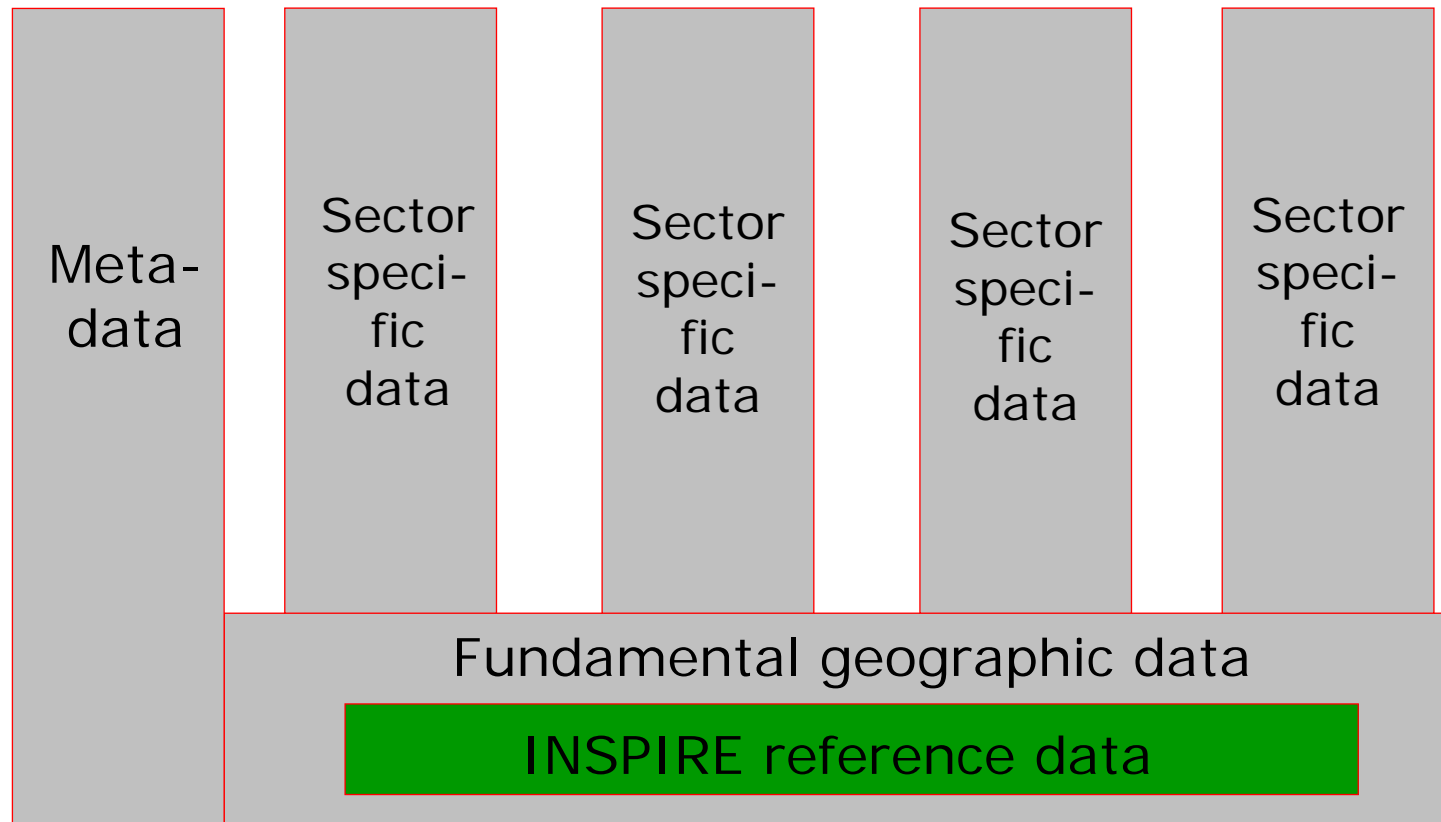
