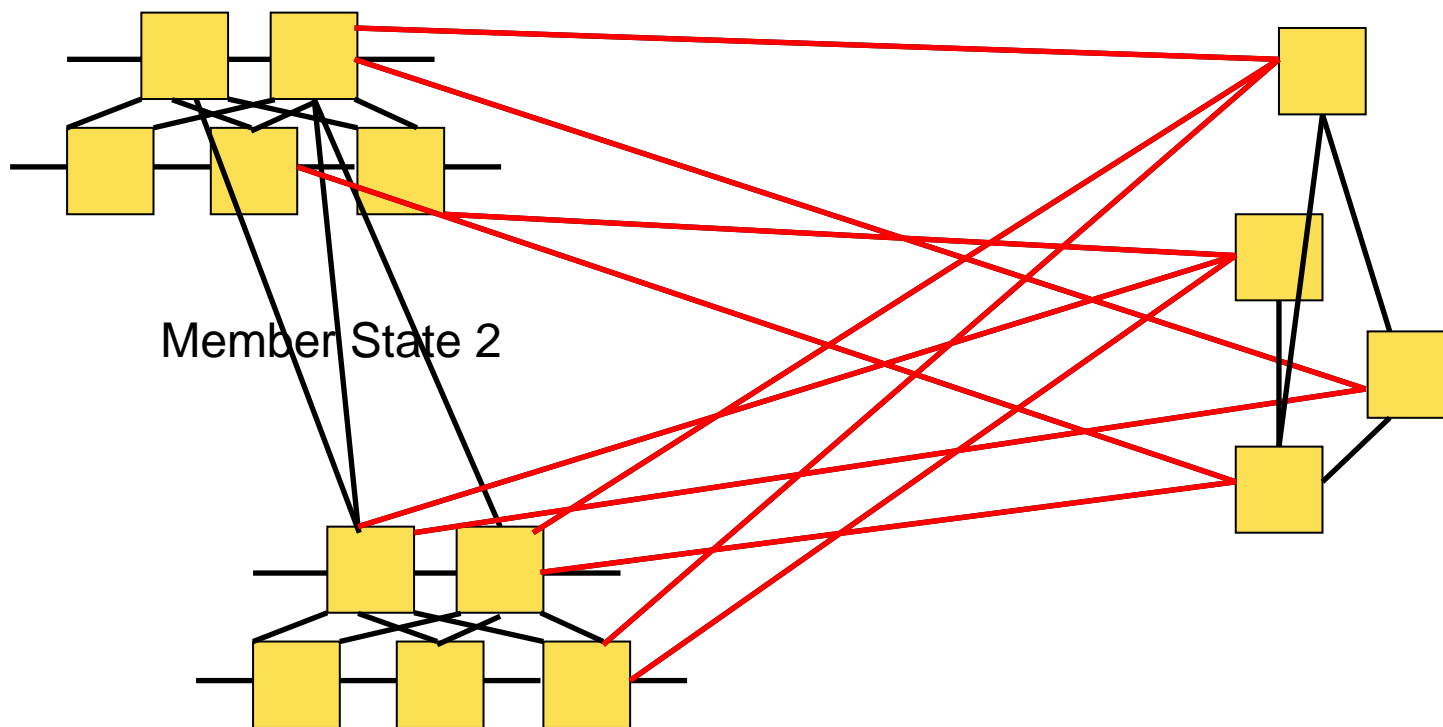

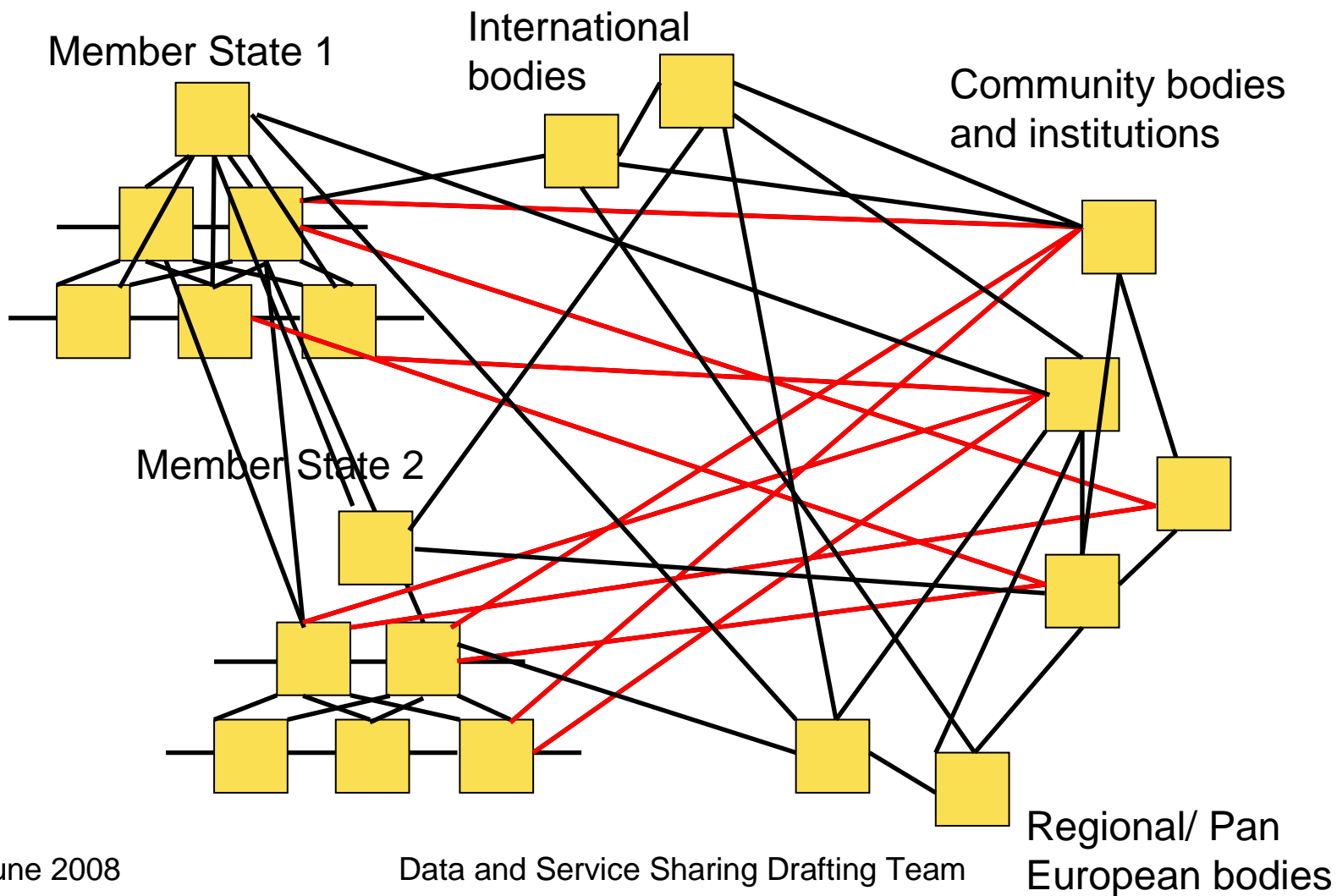

Principles

- 🍍 Based on user requirements (i.e. those of Community institutions and bodies)
- 🍍 Technology-neutral
- 🍍 Pragmatic approach to what can be harmonised
- 🍍 Progressive move towards common terminology, licence structure and content



Approach

- 🍌 Preference for upstream framework agreements
- 🍌 Transactional licences - Basic and Specific
- 🍌 Measures to make Directive work
- 🍌 Designed for data sharing between public authority and Community body, but able to be used as good practice example in other situations



Drafts

- 🍍 First draft Implementing Rules and Commentary (D4.9a) to Coordination Team November 2007
- 🍍 Second Drafts (D4.9b) to Coordination Team in April 2008
- 🍍 Draft Recommendations document(s) in production at present



Current situation and next steps

- 🍌 Outline comments on D4.9b received earlier this month from Coordination Team.
- 🍌 Some detailed suggestions received from CT - DT to consider at next meeting
- 🍌 Commission are investigating issues relating to:
 - 🍌 impact of Commission procurement regulations
 - 🍌 degree of detail to be included in implementing rule (as opposed to guidance)



Next steps

- 🍌 Review Coordination Team's comments and suggestions on draft implementing rule and commentary
- 🍌 Receive further information from Commission
- 🍌 Re-draft as necessary and re-submit to CT
- 🍌 Complete draft Recommendations document and submit to CT
